Although the LEO FRANK case is remembered for its supreme injustice, hero-GOVERNOR SLATON of Georgia, crucial figure in the tragedy, lacks a biographer. And so others - UPTON SINCLAIR, unknown as Southerner, THEODORE DREISER, falsely seen as a "Progressive," ROBERT M. LAFOLLETTE, demeaned in his own Wisconsin, TOM DEWEY...& many more, prove that History is "boring" only if the reader is led astray or reads wrongly.
