But, with my limited knowledge of India' foreign policy (largely collected from newspapers, magazines and the web), I could infer lack of balance in the book. The book could have been more balanced in at least two ways. First, almost a third of the book is devoted to foreign policy under Manmohan Singh (i.e. since 2005). Other foreign policy makers (Nehru, Gujral, Vajpayee) and events (India's missile program) surely deserve greater attention. Secondly, and more importantly, the book clearly favors one political party over all others that have been in power. Nowhere is this more apparent than in the description of the Emergency and post Pokhran 1998 foreign policy.
